

City is a place that was designed for people to live together, meet and socialise. The more people gather together and speak to each other the better you can experience identity and the soul of the city.

In our pavilion every visitor triggers a pre-recorded audio sample of common city life phrases in lithuanian, latvian and estonian languages therefore creating city-like sound. Pre-recorded phrases overlap each other with every new visitor entering pavilion. You can experience emptiness and silence of the city when you are all alone in the pavilion, but this changes to noisy city-like atmosphere with more and more people coming in.


Visitors of the pavilion can take a part of soul of the city away as a souvenir. People can take folded card with a small speaker repeating same phrases you hear in the pavilion. At the same time people are introduced to a baltic culture through sound and visual icons of architectural landmarks. Souvenir also offers a chance to learn the actual phrase you hear.

Walls of the pavilion are filled with hangers that hold all folded cards – souvenirs. A set of directional speakers are integrated into the ceilling of the pavilion. Directional speakers enables you to focus a beam of sound to a specific point in the pavilion and to address visitors with precise acoustic content at precise locations. Speakers deliver a narrow beam of sound to a pavilion area while preserving silence around it.


The structure of the pavilion, that holds souvenirs and speakers, can be rented localy. Hangers and folded cards are made out of sustainable materials like wood or paper.
