Qualification of conceptual designs for the public procurement *Two-Stage Ideas Competition with Pre-Qualification for the New Administrative Building of the Tallinn city Government*.

On the basis of the Public Procurement Act; section 8, subsection 2 of the Administrative Procedure Act; clause 4.2.2 of the statutes of the Tallinn City Planning Department approved by Tallinn City Council regulation no. 43 of December 9, 2004; annex 1 (*Qualification Requirements for Public Procurements*) of directive no. PO-1/158 issued by the Mayor of Tallinn May 22, 2007; and the proposal made in the minutes of the qualification of conceptual designs by the qualification committee formed in accordance with the Tallinn City Planning Department directive no. 1-6/57 of September 1, 2008

1.
